



## Application for early submission of Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) thesis

Candidates undertaking a Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) at the University of Sydney are required to submit the thesis for examination after a minimum length of candidature.

Queries relating to the early submission of a PhD thesis should be directed to the appropriate faculty office in the first instance.

This form is to be used for applications to be considered in accordance with part 5, section 13 of the *University of Sydney (Doctor of Philosophy (PhD)) Rule 2004*. This clause states that in exceptional circumstances, the Chair of the Academic Board may accept for examination a PhD thesis submitted by a candidate enrolled for less than the minimum length of candidature.

Applications submitted in accordance with this provision are considered on a case-by-case basis. All PhD requirements must be met, including that the work submitted was undertaken during candidature, and evidence must be produced that the candidate has made exceptional progress during candidature.

Applications for consideration by the Chair of the Academic Board should be completed by the candidate, supervisor and head of department/school<sup>1</sup> and submitted to the appropriate faculty office<sup>2</sup> for a recommendation from the Dean<sup>3</sup> to the Chair of the Academic Board.

To complete the application:

1. **clearly state the length of time by which candidature is requested to be reduced (and thesis to be submitted early) and the reason; and**
2. **attach any supporting documentation**
