No non-Business School/School of Economics units (e.g. GOVT, ECOP or language units) can be completed as part of the International Business major in the combined Law degree.

Students should note that this example has been developed using 2012 unit of study offerings and there is no guarantee that the units listed will be offered in the same semesters in subsequent years.
- iv. Certain units of study listed above may also be offered in Summer or Winter School sessions.
