



## University of Sydney Travel Insurance Schedule

Students enrolled at the University of Sydney are covered by the University's travel insurance for all required University related travel.

### **In regards to USYD CEMS exchange (outgoing) the following applies:**

1. Students are covered for the period in which they are enrolled in a CEMS Academic member institution as a part of the exchange component of his/her Master of Management (CEMS) degree. Enrolment at the University of Sydney must remain active for this period.
2. Students must be enrolled full time, in accordance with the degree requirements, and at the CEMS institution allocated during the selection process at the University of Sydney.
1. Prior to departure students must confirm in writing the CEMS institution they will be enrolled in and the relevant semester dates. Confirmation should be emailed to the Student Coordinator, Lance Graham [l.graham@econ.usyd.edu.au](mailto:l.graham@econ.usyd.edu.au)
2. Students will only be covered for a maximum of 365 days of approved University related travel (relating to points 1 and 2 above).
3. Upon completion of studies within agreed exchange arrangements, insurance cover will cease to continue. At this point students are responsible for making their own arrangements for travel insurance.
4. Students studying in his/her country of citizenship/residence will not be covered by the University travel insurance.
