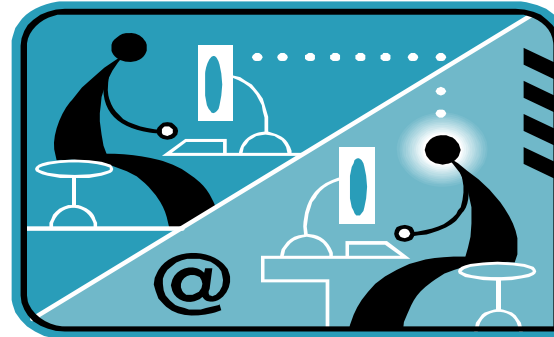

- 2 hours or overnight from the Reserve collection

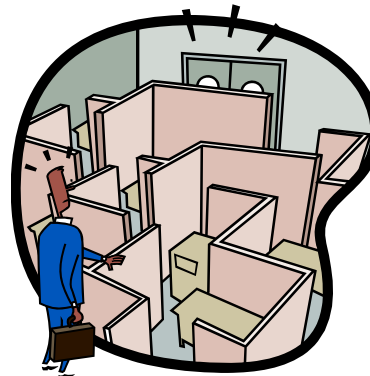
