Notes

- i. The units students complete for a major in Japanese Studies depends on their language level at the commencement of their studies. For example, students with none of little previous exposure to Japanese language would begin with junior units (e.g. JPNS1611 and JPNS1612) and students with HSC study in Japanese may begin at a higher level (e.g. Students with 65% or higher in HSC Japanese Beginners would start with JPNS2621 and JPNS2622). Students who wish to major in Japanese Studies must take at least 36 senior credit points (2000 or 3000 level) from a combination of language and studies components. A minimum of 24 credit points must be taken from language components and a minimum of 12 credit points must be taken from studies components at the appropriate Japanese language levels. - ii. The International Business major requires the completion of one junior unit of study from the Business School – the junior core units meet this requirement.
