#### Notes

- i. For a Finance major, it is recommended that students complete BUSS1040 (or ECON1001 and ECON1002) and BUSS1020 (or ECMT1010). Therefore, in this example, BUSS1040 and BUSS1020 are completed as electives in the first year of study.
- ii. For a major in International Business, students must complete one junior unit of study from the Business School for the major – the core units for the degree cover this requirement. Other junior units may be required to be completed as prerequisites for some of the senior electives in the International Business major.
- iii. This program of study is meant to be a guide only. Students are able to undertake the required units of study and elective in different sequences to that listed above. Students should note that this example has been developed using 2012 unit of study offerings and there is no guarantee that the units listed will be offered in the same semesters in subsequent years.
- iv. Certain units of study listed above may also be offered in Summer or Winter School sessions.
