

Business Information Systems major

For students who commenced prior to 2006

For a Business Information Systems major students are required to complete **44 credit points** in units of study (including **32 credit points** in senior units) comprising:

- (i) **Two junior units of study (12 credit points):**
 - **ACCT1002 Accounting 1B** OR **ACCT1004 Management Accounting Concepts** (6 credit points)
 - **INFS5000 Foundations of Business Information Systems** (6 credit points)
- (ii) **Two compulsory senior units of study (16 credit points)*:**
 - **INFS2000 Business Information Systems** (8 credit points) (or INFS2001 *Business Information Systems/IS for Performance Improvement* (6 credit points) from 2006)
 - **INFS2005 Business Process Integration and Modelling** (8 credit points) (or INFS2020 *Business Process Integration and Modelling / Business Process Modelling and Improvement* (6 credit points) from 2006)
- (iii) **At least 16 credit points in senior elective units of study*selected from the following options:**
 - **CLAW2006 Legal Issues for e-Commerce** (8 credit points) (or CLAW2206 *Legal Issues for e-Commerce* (6 credit points) from 2006)
 - **ECHS2328 The Politics of e-Commerce** (8 credit points)
 - **INFS3000 Management Information Systems** (8 credit points) (or INFS3060 *Management Information Systems / Managing BIS Projects / Managing Digital Innovation Projects* (6 credit points) from 2006)
 - **INFS3005 Enterprise Systems** (8 credit points) (or INFS3040 *Enterprise Systems / Enterprise Systems and Integrated Business* (6 credit points) from 2006)
 - **INFS3010 IT Assurance and Control** (8 credit points) (or INFS3030 *IT Assurance and Control / BIS Assurance and Control / Information Protection and Assurance* (6 credit points) from 2006)
 - **INFS3015 Knowledge Management Systems** (8 credit points) (or INFS2010 *Managing Information and Knowledge Assets / Digital Information Design and Management* (6 credit points) from 2006)
 - **INFS3020 e-Commerce Business Models** (8 credit points) (or INFS2030 *e-Commerce Business Models / e-Commerce Business Management* (6 credit points) from 2006)
 - **INFS3090 Business Information Systems Project** (8 credit points)
 - **MKTG3010 Electronic Marketing** (8 credit points) (or MKTG3110 *Electronic Marketing* (6 credit points) from 2006)
 - Any elective units offered in subsequent years under the Business Information Systems major.

* Note from 2006 all senior units of study were standardised to be worth six credit points. Continuing students have to complete either the six credit point unit which replaced the pre-2006 eight-credit point unit and a 2 credit point extension unit (e.g. codes ACCT9001 to 9004) OR additional six credit point electives to meet the minimum 32 senior credit point requirements for this major.

Business Information Systems double major

For students who commenced prior to 2006

For a Business Information Systems double major students are required to complete 60 credit points in units of study (including 48 credit points in senior units) comprising:

- (i) Two junior units (12 credit points): ACCT1002 (or ACCT1004) and INFS1000
- (ii) Two senior units (16 credit points): INFS2000/INFS2001 and INFS2005/INFS2020
- (iii) At least 32 credit points in elective senior units of study selected from those offered for the single major.
