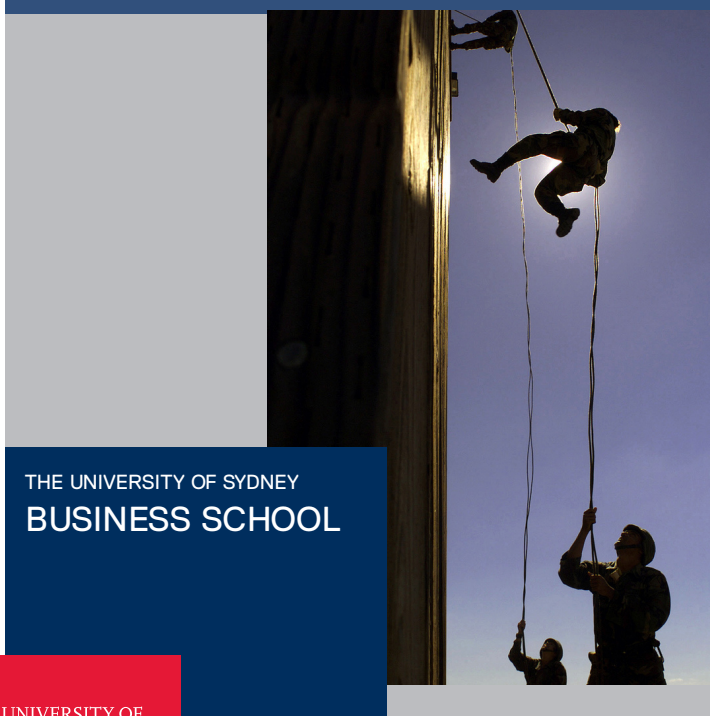

The Master of Management Scholarship promotes academic excellence in pre-experience management education.

ELIGIBILITY

The Master of Management scholarship is open to all local students who successfully gain entry to the Master of Management or the Master of Management CEMS and will be in continuous full time study with the Business School.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The scholarship is awarded to the most outstanding candidate against the degree selection criteria, which include (but are not limited to) the candidate's:

- academic achievement
- motivation to achieve
- personal integrity
- international orientation
- performance in the selection interview

Candidate performance against the criteria is assessed by an admissions committee who will shortlist applicants and make a recommendation for the awarding of the scholarship to the Faculty Executive Committee.

VALUE

Up to two scholarships are available for award each year. One scholarship may be offered each semester. The scholarship is tenable for one full year and covers tuition fees for up to ten units of study. Specifically, the scholarship is valued at \$36,600 in 2012.

The University of Sydney Business School will pay the student's tuition fees at the commencement of the student's semester, pending academic progression.

The Business School acknowledges that the study fees may vary on an annual basis and the scholarship value may vary. Students who receive this scholarship may still be required to pay other costs associated with University enrolment (e.g. student administration fees).

SELECTION PROCESS

As part of the Admissions process, all candidates are interviewed by the admissions committee. There is no separate application process for the scholarship.

Once all interviews are completed, the admissions committee will draft a shortlist and make a recommendation for awarding to the Faculty Executive Committee (FEC).

In the event that the FEC is unable to agree on who should be awarded the scholarship, a subcommittee will be established and may seek further information from shortlisted candidates to assist in making a decision.

The Scholarship may be shared if the final candidates are of equal standing.

The University of Sydney Business School reserves the right not to award the scholarship, if the selection committee deliberates that the selection criteria has not been met to a sufficient standard for award.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

The scholarship is only tenable in the Master of Management or the Master of Management (CEMS) at the University of Sydney Business School.

If the scholarship holder changes degrees or discontinues study, the scholarship will no longer be tenable.

The scholarship must be taken up in the semester in which it is offered. That is, the scholarship holder is not able to defer or suspend their enrolment in the degree.

To retain the scholarship, the holder must maintain a full-time study load each semester and achieve academic progression with at least a 75 percent average each semester.

The scholarship holder will have the opportunity to promote the Master of Management coursework program and present for publicity purposes.
