Notes

- i. For a major in Germanic Studies students complete units based on the level of language proficiency. Students with little or no experience of the language complete GRMN1111, GRMN1112, GRMN2611, GRMN2612, GRMN2613, GRMN2614, GRMN2631 and six credit points in senior non-language Germanic Studies elective (a minimum of 12 credit points in non-language senior units must be completed). Students with HSC Beginners or German Continuers (mark of below 70) complete GRMN1211, GRMN1222, GRMN2613, GRMN2614, GRMN2615 and 18 credit points senior language or non-language Germanic Studies electives (a minimum of 18 credit points in non-language electives must be completed). Students with HSC German Extension or HSC German Continuers (mark of 70+) complete GRMN1311, GRMN1322, GRMN2617, GRMN2618 and 24 credit points in other senior language and non-language Germanic Studies electives (a minimum of 18 credit points in non-language senior units must be completed).
