	Commercial Law	Students must complete 1 or 2 junior (6 or 12 credit points) + 6 or 7 senior units (36 or 42 credit points) = 8 units (48 credit points) (No core units are part of this major)										
	Econometrics	Students must complete 1 junior + 6 senior units (42 credit points) outside of the core units (Core unit in this major is: ECMT1010)										
	Economics	Students must complete 1 junior unit (12 credit points) + 6 senior units (36 credit points) = 7 units (42 credit points) outside of the core units (Core units included in this major are: ECON1001, ECON1002 & ECMT1010)										
	Finance	Students must complete 5 senior units (30 credit points) outside of the core units (Core units included in this major are: ACCT1001, ECMT1010, ECON1001, ECON1002, & FINC2011)										
	IR & HRM	Students must complete 1 junior unit (6 credit points) + 6 senior units (36 credit points) = 7 units (42 credit points) outside of the core units (Core unit in this major WORK2218)										
	International Business	Students must complete 5 senior units (30 credit points) outside of the core units (Core unit is this major is: CISS2001)										
	Management	Students must complete 4 senior units (24 credit points) outside of the core units (Core units included in this major are: ECON1001, ECON1002, MKTG1001, ECOF3001 & WORK2218. If students wish to complete other junior units from WORK or GOVT to allow for more variety of senior electives, then this will restrict the majors with which they combine with the Management major. GOVT units are Faculty of Arts units).										
	Operations Management and Decision Sciences +	Students must complete 1 junior unit (6 credit points) + 6 senior units (36 credit points) outside of the core units = 7 units (Core unit in this major is: ECMT1010)										
	Marketing	Students must complete 1 junior unit (6 credit points) + 6 senior units (36 credit points) = 7 units (42 credit points) outside of the core units (Core unit included in this major MKTG1001 or MKTG2010)										
	Professional accreditation in accounting	Students must complete 1 junior (6 credit points) + 8 senior units (48 credit points) = 9 units (54 credit points) outside of the core units. (Core units required to meet CPA accreditation are: ACCT1001, ACCT1002, ECMT1010, ECON1001, ECON1002, & FINC2011. Core requirements to meet CA accreditation are: ACCT1001, ACCT1002 & FINC2011.)
