Notes

- i. For a major in Government & International Relations, students complete 12 credit points in junior units and 36 credit points in senior units of study. For full details of these majors, please refer to the [Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences handbook](#).
- ii. In this example, units offered by the School of Economics (ECON, ECOS and ECMT units) are being counted towards the Commerce component of the combined degree (Business School). Therefore for the Arts component the student completes 72 credit points in senior units from other Arts Table A areas (excluding those offered by the School of Economics).
- iii. This program of study is meant to be a guide only. Students are able to undertake the required units of study in different sequences to that listed above. Students should note that this example has been developed using 2012 unit of study offerings and there is no guarantee that the units listed will be offered in the same semesters in subsequent years.
- iv. Certain units of study listed above may also be offered in Summer or Winter School sessions.
