#### Notes

- i. For a major in Art History, students complete ARHT1001, ARHT1002 and 36 credit points in senior Art History units of study. For full details of this major, please refer to the [Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences handbook](#).
- ii. For a major in Film Studies, students complete 18 credit points in junior units, including either ARHT1002 or ENGL1026 (in this example both are completed) and 36 credit points in senior units of study, including ARHT2652, ARHT2655, FILM2601 and FILM2660. Students can count ARHT2652 and ARHT2655 to either an Art History or a Film Studies major but not both. In this example, these units are counted towards the Film Studies major. - iii. This program of study is meant to be a guide only. Students are able to undertake the required units of study in different sequences to that listed above.
