OVERVIEW

Tuition Scholarships are intended to provide a contribution to the cost of tuition. This Scholarship provides an opportunity for future international postgraduate students to offset the cost of their tuition at CET.

Valued at up to \$A1,000.

BACKGROUND

The scholarships were first established in 2011 and funded by CET. The scholarships titled 'The CET Tuition Scholarship', is intended for students enrolled in a CET academic or general English language course and to provide a degree of targeted financial support.

PURPOSE

The scholarships were established to provide an incentive for further participation in the CET academic and general English courses. In addition to the general conditions for CET Scholarships, the following special conditions apply to CET Tuition Scholarships:

VALUE/TENSURE/PAYMENT

A CET Tuition Scholarship is worth up to \$1,000 in any one academic year, to be paid at the at the awards ceremony. The number, and value, of CET Tuition Scholarships available each year is at the discretion of the Director, CET

ELIGIBILITY

CET Tuition Scholarships are awarded to recipients who are enrolled full-time in any CET course.

Applicants are assessed on personal attributes such as contribution to research at CET and the University of Sydney, and contribution to diversity at CET and the University.

There is no minimum academic requirement for a CET Tuition Scholarship.

SELECTION CRITERIA

A selection panel will comprise: the CET Director (or nominee), CET Deputy Director (or nominee), and one member of CET teaching or administrative staff. Selection will be based on the selection committee's assessment of the suitability of the award to provide a reasonable contribution to the cost of an international student's potential to benefit from receipt of a CET Tuition Scholarship.

Applicants are assessed on merit, particularly personal attributes such as contribution to research and contribution to diversity. The selection panel may assess and rank each candidate at the panel's discretion. Where it is deemed appropriate, the panel may seek additional information on short-listed candidates prior to making a final decision.

Payment will be arranged at one of two scholarship events.

There is no minimum academic requirement for a CET Tuition Scholarship.

PROHIBITIONS/ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

A CET Tuition Scholarship may only be awarded once to any recipient.

A CET Tuition Scholarship must be used whilst a student is enrolled in a full-time course at CET.

A CET Tuition Scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other CET Scholarship. Government-sponsored students, such as AusAID, World Bank and Asian Development Bank students are ineligible to apply for a CET Tuition Scholarship.

The scholarship shall be terminated if the recipient withdraws from the agreed program at CET.

Once terminated, a CET Tuition Scholarship will not be reinstated.

CET reserves the right to reallocate a scholarship if terms of the award are not met.
