OVERVIEW

CET BECAS CHILE & COLFUTURO Scholarships are intended to provide a degree of targeted financial support to three high potential BECAS CHILE or COLFUTURO scholarship holders who have accepted a package offer for an eligible Faculty of Economics and Business Masters degree and to undertake studies at the Centre for English Teaching (CET).

Valued at up to \$A1,000.

BACKGROUND

The scholarships were first established in 2010 and commencing for award in 2011 funded by the Faculty of Economics and Business. The scholarships shall be titled 'The Faculty of Economics and Business BECAS CHILE & COLFUTURO Awards'. It is intended that the scholarships will provide a degree of targeted financial support to three high potential BECAS CHILE or COLFUTURO scholarship holders who have accepted a package offer for an eligible Faculty of Economics and Business Masters degree and to undertake studies at the Centre for English Teaching (CET).

PURPOSE

The scholarships were established to provide an incentive for further participation in Faculty programs by BECAS CHILE and COLFUTURO award holders, particularly as a means of supporting the Faculty's desire to diversify the postgraduate coursework student cohort. It is envisioned the scholarships will help to further relationships with BECAS CHILE and COLFUTURO students, as well as with our partner organisations in Chile and Colombia.

In addition to the general conditions for CET Scholarships, the following special conditions apply to CET BECAS CHILE & COLFUTURO Scholarships:

VALUE/TENSURE/PAYMENT

The scholarships are valued at a total AUD\$1,000 each to be paid on commencement of studies in a Faculty of Economics and Business postgraduate coursework masters program excepting the Master of Management and the Executive MBA program. Up to three scholarships are available each year.

ELIGIBILITY

These scholarships are available to all students who have accepted a package offer for a Faculty of Economics and Business postgraduate coursework masters program other than the Master of Management and Executive MBA program; have achieved a minimum IELTS overall score of 6.0 (or equivalent) on applying for admission; and who will undertake a CET English language program of 11 weeks or less.

SELECTION CRITERIA

A selection panel will comprise: the CET Director (or nominee), CET Deputy Director (or nominee), and one member of CET teaching or administrative staff. Selection will be based on the selection committee's assessment of the suitability of the award to provide a reasonable contribution to the cost of an international student's potential to benefit from receipt of a CET Tuition Scholarship.

Applicants are assessed on merit, particularly personal attributes such as contribution to research and contribution to diversity. The selection panel may assess and rank each candidate at the panel's discretion. Where it is deemed appropriate, the panel may seek additional information on short-listed candidates prior to making a final decision.

There is no minimum academic requirement for a CET Tuition Scholarship.

PROHIBITIONS/ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

This scholarship is tenable in a Masters by coursework program with the Faculty of Economics and Business excepting the Master of Management and the Executive MBA program.

The recipient must be admitted and enrolled in an eligible degree at the time of payment.

Withdrawal or transfer from the agreed degree before completion and without Faculty permission will make the holder liable to return funding in full.

The scholarship must be taken up in the semester in which it is offered. That is, scholarship holders are not able to defer or suspend their enrolment in the degree.

CET reserves the right to reallocate a scholarship if terms of the award are not met.
