

# Your go-to guide to myki

Your ticket for trains, trams  
and buses in Melbourne

myki is a reusable travel card –  
your ticket for trains, trams and  
buses in Melbourne and many  
parts of regional Victoria.

This simple guide includes:

- topping up with myki Money  
and myki Pass
- metropolitan fares
- touching on and off
- Free Tram Zone map.

## Buy your myki card and top up

A Full fare card costs \$6, \$3 concession.

You can buy your myki and top up at:

- around 800 shops including all 7-Elevens
- myki machines at selected stations and stops
- premium station ticket offices
- PTV Hubs
- on the bus (\$20 max)
- [ptv.vic.gov.au](http://ptv.vic.gov.au) or by calling **1800 800 007** (allow seven days for delivery of a myki and around 90 minutes for online top ups).

Concession types include Child, Senior and general Concession. Check if you're eligible at [ptv.vic.gov.au/concession](http://ptv.vic.gov.au/concession)

### myki Money

If you travel occasionally, pay as you go.

Load money onto your card and myki will calculate the lowest fare based on where you travel.

Your first touch on of the day creates a 2 hour fare.

If you're still travelling after 2 hours, you'll be charged a daily fare.

### Your card isn't locked to myki Money or myki Pass – choose each time you top up.

You can have myki Money and a myki Pass on your card at the same time, but your card will use myki Pass first.

Your myki Pass won't work if your myki Money has a negative balance.

### myki Pass

If you travel often, top up with consecutive days.

When you travel more than five days a week, you save with a myki Pass.

Compare seven days' travel for Zone 1+2.

myki Money **\$55.60** (5 x Daily, 2 x Weekend Daily)  
myki Pass **\$43.00** (7 day pass)

### Trains

Remember to touch on and off.

### Trams

Remember to touch on, you don't need to touch off.

Don't touch on or off if you're just travelling in the city's Free Tram Zone.

Only touch off on trams if you're just travelling in Zone 2. (For more on zones visit [ptv.vic.gov.au/zones](http://ptv.vic.gov.au/zones))



## Register online to protect your card

- Secure your card's balance if it's lost or stolen.
- See the cost of your recent trips and balance.
- Set Auto Top Up.
- Request a replacement card when yours expires, every four years.
- Manage multiple cards.

## myki Explorer pack

If you're a visitor, enjoy a ready-to-use myki card with one day's unlimited travel on public transport in Melbourne.

Your pack also includes handy maps, a souvenir wallet and discounts to lots of our favourite places. If you want to keep travelling, just top up your myki.

Buy yours from:

- Melbourne Visitor Centre in Federation Square
- SkyBus terminals at Melbourne Airport and Southern Cross Station
- PTV Hubs in Melbourne and regional Victoria
- the concierge desk at many hotels and accommodation providers.

A Full fare myki Explorer pack costs \$15, \$7.50 concession.

Don't touch on and off if you're just travelling in the Free Tram Zone.

Look for the signs at tram stops to identify zone boundaries.
