



Application for Reassessment of Liability Status for Commonwealth Supported Students

This form should be completed if you are enrolled in a course of study as Commonwealth supported where you have undertaken study at another Australian institution, and your enrolment or liability status in the previous course of study was such that it may determine the liability status of the course of study now being undertaken. Please read the following information carefully.

Determining your HECS status

You are considered a **pre-2008 HECS liable** student if:

You commenced a course of study prior to 1 January 2008 and were a Commonwealth supported student in relation to a unit of study in that course.

1. You have not completed that course; and,
 - are continuing the same course; or
 - have transferred into a new course; or
 - are undertaking cross-institutional study in relation to that course.

Or;

2. You have completed that course; however,
 - it was an enabling course; or
 - it was the related course for an honours course of study and you are now undertaking the honours course of study; or
 - you have transferred into a new course (including where the transfer is from an undergraduate course to a postgraduate course or the reverse).

If you studied as a HECS student prior to 1 January 2005 but have not undertaken any study between 1 January 2005 and 31 December 2007 as a Commonwealth supported student you are not eligible to be considered a pre-2008 student.

Transitional pre-2008 arrangements will continue until 31 December 2012.

You are considered a **pre-2009 HECS liable** student if:

You commenced a course of study between 1 January and 31 December 2008 and were a Commonwealth supported student in relation to a unit of study in that course.

You have not completed the course; and,

- are continuing in the same course; or
- are transferring into a new course - with the exception of where you are transferring from a non-Natural and Physical Science course of study to a Natural and Physical Science course of study (see below).

For this purpose a combined or double degree is considered a single course of study.

You are considered a **Pre-2010 HECS liable** student if:

1. You commenced a course of study between 1 January and 31 December 2009 and were Commonwealth supported in relation to a unit of study in that course.

You have not completed that course; and,

- are continuing that same course; or,
- have transferred to a new course.

Or;

2. You commenced a non-Natural and Physical Science course of study between 1 January and 31 December 2008 and were Commonwealth supported in relation to a unit in that course. You have not completed the course, and have transferred courses in to a Natural and Physical Science course of study.*

You are considered a **pre-2008/2009-on HECS liable** student if:

You meet the requirements as stated above regarding pre-2008 eligibility, and in addition are transferring from a non-Natural and Physical Sciences course of study to a Natural and Physical course of study.

You are considered a **pre-2009/2010-on HECS liable** student if:

You commenced a course of study prior to 1 January 2009 and were not Commonwealth supported in relation to a unit of study in that course and are now Commonwealth supported. You are now either in the same course or have transferred to a different course, however, have not transferred from a non-Natural and Physical Science course of study to a Natural and Physical Science course of study.

Only original documents or photocopies certified by the issuing institution or Justices of the Peace will be accepted.
