Country	University	Scholarship
China	Shanghai Normal University	Free accommodation and living allowance of RMB 800 per month (approximately \$120 AUD).
France	Université François Rabelais de Tours	€500 per student (approx. \$600 AUD) per student per semester awarded for highest WAM.
UK	University of Exeter	2 scholarships are available for March 2013 each worth £500 awarded for highest WAM.
South Korea	Korea University	Includes an Admission Scholarships for KRW300,000 (approximately \$250 AUD) per month for 4 months. Award on WAM.
Switzerland	Université de Genève	5 x scholarships for CHF 800 (approx. \$800 AUD) per month for 4 months available for March 2013 awarded for highest WAM.

### OS-HELP Loans

The Australian Government offers a loan scheme to undergraduate Australian residents to participate in an overseas study experience. In 2012, loans are available at \$1,100, \$3,300 and \$5,824. The 2013 loans amounts will be indexed upwards at the rate of inflation. These loans are added to any existing HECS-HELP debt. These loans cannot be granted during the first year or last semester of your undergraduate course. An Honours year counts as a separate course. Further eligibility criteria is available from the International Office. There are two deadlines per year.
