# SUCCESSFUL LEARNING CONFERENCE 2010

### Keynote Speakers

STEPHEN N. ELLIOTT PhD is a Professor of Special Education and the Dunn Family Chair of Educational and Psychological Assessment in Peabody College at Vanderbilt University, USA. Steve teaches courses on measurement and assessment of academic and social behaviour. He currently co-directs three USDE research grants concerning the assessment of learning-focused school leadership and the validity of testing modifications and alternate assessments for students with disabilities. Steve has authored more than 200 journal articles, books and chapters, and five widely used behavior-rating scales. Through his research contributions on assessment and students with disabilities, he has achieved Fellow status in the American Educational Research Association and the American Psychological Association. The latter also selected Steve as a Senior Scientist in 2009.

EDWARD J. KAME'ENUI PhD is Dean-Knight Professor of Education, and Director of the Institute for the Development of Educational Achievement and the Center on Teaching and Learning, in the College of Education at the University of Oregon, USA. From 2005–07, he served as the first commissioner of the National Center for Special Education Research in the Institute of Education Sciences, within the U.S. Department of Education. He has co-authored more than a dozen college textbooks and has published more than 130 research journal articles and book chapters. Dr Kame'enui's areas of research and teaching expertise include early literacy and language development, school-wide reading improvement, the design of high-quality educational materials, learning disabilities, vocabulary development, and the architecture of instruction.

This annual conference focuses on the provision of quality education for students K–12 who experience difficulties learning in a mainstream classroom setting. Areas addressed include literacy and numeracy, accountability and assessment, behaviour management and social skills instruction. Presentations and workshops will be given by academics, consultants, and practitioners from all NSW education sectors and invited speakers from interstate and overseas.

## CERTIFICATE IN EDUCATIONAL STUDIES (LEARNING SUPPORT)

Conference + 12 & 26 August, 9 & 23 September, 21 October | 4.30–7.30pm

(For teachers outside the wider Sydney metropolitan region, workshop attendance is available by videoconference.)

This program will examine in detail the theories, policies and practices that promote quality literacy and numeracy learning outcomes across a range of Key Learning Areas, for students identified as experiencing difficulties learning in a mainstream classroom environment. Specific focus will be placed on teachers working as part of teams to promote individualised programs and processes that assist students with additional learning needs to achieve collaboratively established learning outcomes. Workshop activities and individual learning tasks will promote the integration of theory and practice across early childhood, primary and secondary settings.

### Assessment & Accreditation

To receive the Certificate in Educational Studies (Learning Support), teachers must attend and actively participate in all sessions (Both days of the Successful Learning Conference 2010 and five evening workshops).

Successful participants have the option of having this program accredited as one unit of study towards the faculty's Master of Education (MEd) program, or the shorter Graduate Certificate or Graduate Diploma in Educational Studies levels. This involves submitting two additional assessment tasks, and an additional fee applies.
