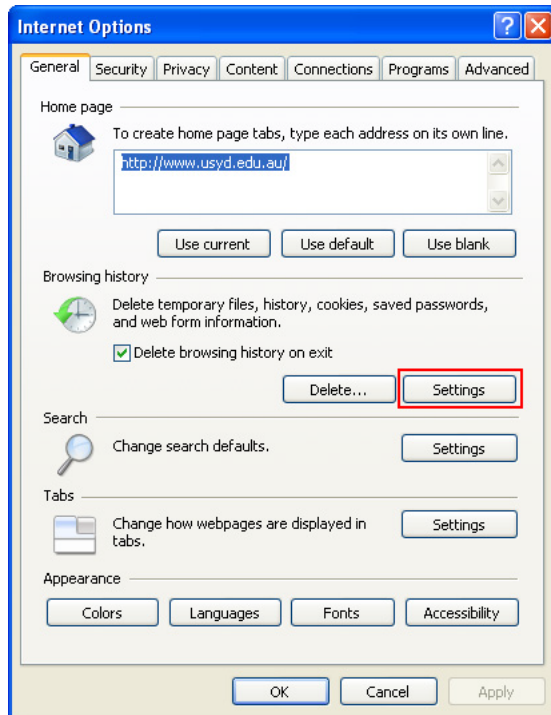
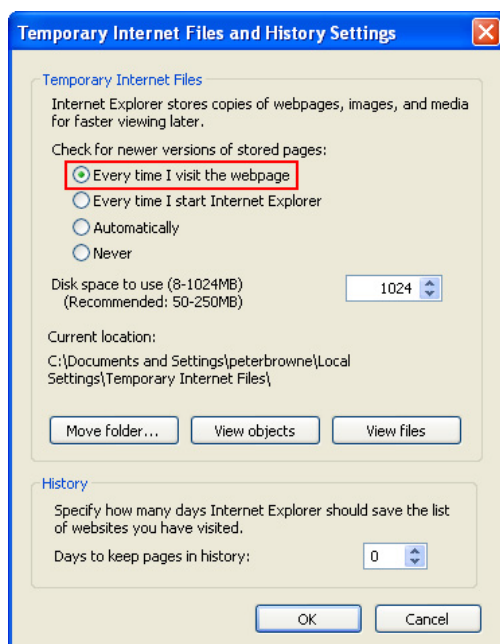


Internet Explorer 7/8 settings to allow for mixed-mode content and force clearing of cache

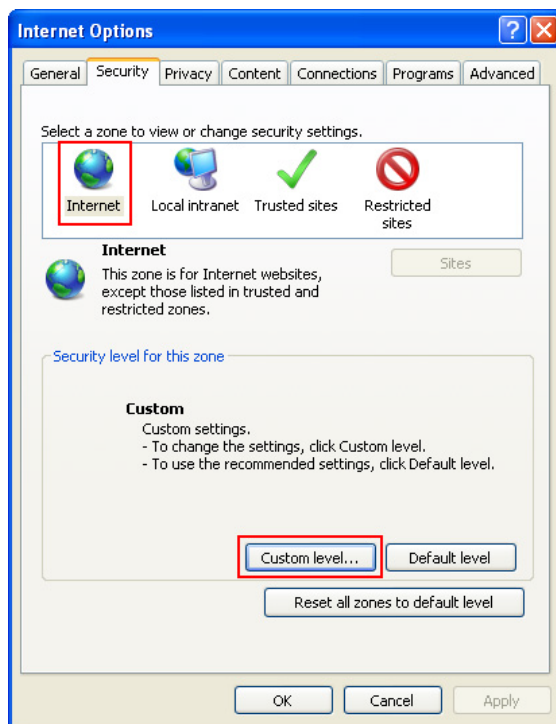
1. Select **Internet Options** from the **Tools** menu.
2. On the **General** tab, click the **Settings** button in the **'Browser history'** group box.



3. The **Temporary Internet Files and History Settings** dialog box will display. The **'Check for newer versions of stored pages'** options should be set to **'Every time I visit the webpage'**. Click **OK**.

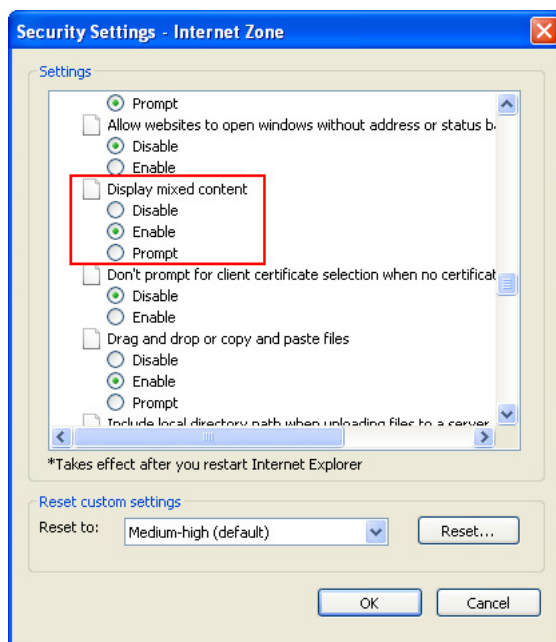


4. On the **Security** tab, select the **Internet** zone and then click the **Custom level** button.

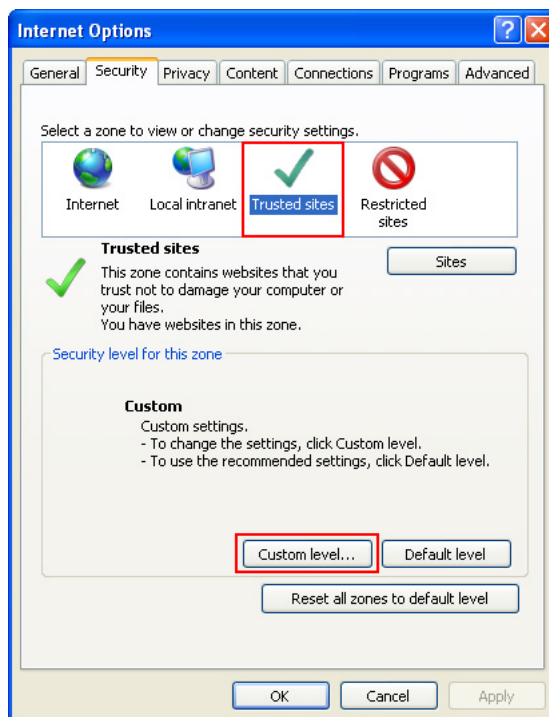


The **Security Settings** dialog box will display.

5. Scroll down to the '**Miscellaneous**' section and set the radio button for '**Display mixed content**' to **Enable** and click **OK**.

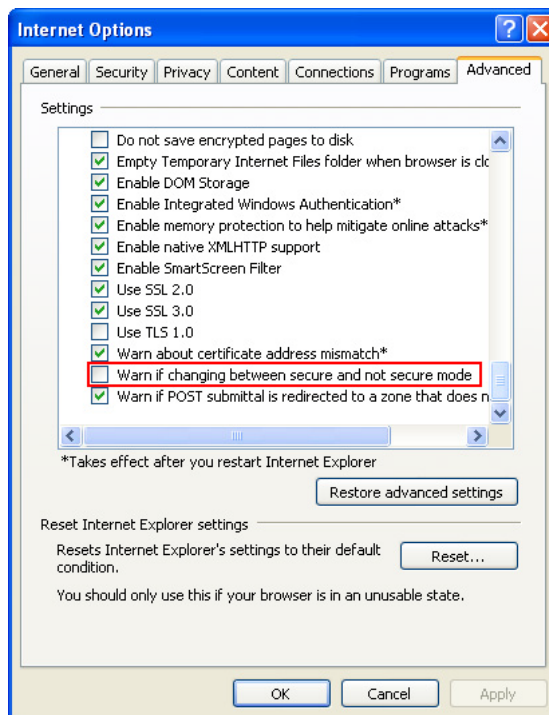


6. Still on the **Security** tab, click on **Trusted sites**.



7. Repeat step 5 above for **Trusted sites**.

8. Click on the **Advanced** tab and scroll and deselect '**Warn if changing between secure and not secure mode**' and click **OK**.



9. Close all Internet Explorer windows and restart the browser.
