At the conclusion of the event, the participant will be able to:

- Understand the general characteristics of stuttering in adolescents and adults
- Understand the role of anxiety when treating adults and adolescents who stutter and know when to refer to a psychologist
- Overview the evidence for stuttering treatments for adults and adolescents
- Choose an appropriate treatment for adults and adolescents
- Know how to implement different treatment techniques for these populations
- Know how to evaluate progress and when to modify the treatment process

Prerequisites for registrants / assumed knowledge or skill base:

Registration is open to all qualified speech pathologists. An interest and preferably some experience in treating stuttering would be useful.

About the Workshop:

The Management of Stuttering in Adolescent and Adult Clients workshop is for speech pathologists. Topics covered will include: the characteristics of adults and adolescents who stutter, anxiety and stuttering, knowing when to treat and when to refer for anxiety management, overview of evidence for different stuttering treatments for the different populations, how and when to use these different treatments, and different service delivery options. Workshop information will be presented by a speech pathologist who specializes in stuttering treatment and research. Learning activities include short lectures, video presentations, small and large group activities and case studies to solve. Each participant will receive a summary of material presented in the workshop. Certificates will be sent to participants at completion of the workshop.

This workshop is presented by CPES which is conducted jointly by the Stuttering Unit at Bankstown Health Service, Australian Stuttering Research Centre at The University of Sydney and The Department of Linguistics, Macquarie University.

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Workshops will only run if minimum participant numbers (20) are met.
