

Application for Concurrent Enrolment

Combined Law students are permitted to concurrently enrol in their non-law degree and the Bachelor of Laws degree under the following conditions:

- (i) a Combined Law student has less than a full-time study load to qualify for the award of their non-law degree and seeks a full-time enrolment by undertaking a limited number of Law 2 units (penultimate year of the Bachelor of Laws);
- (ii) a student may not be enrolled in more than 24 credit points in total per semester;
- (iii) a student may not be concurrently enrolled for more than two semesters. A concurrent enrolment cannot be extended under any circumstances.
- (iv) a student's proposed program of study satisfies the progression rules of the Bachelor of Laws.

If your enrolment is found to exceed 24 credit points per semester during an approved period of concurrent enrolment, approval will be revoked and your enrolment in law units of study will be automatically withdrawn.
