This course of 10 evening lectures provides an introduction to the regulation of employment and labour relations in Australia today. Topics covered include employers' and employees' rights and obligations under the *Fair Work Act* and the common law of employment, anti-discrimination law, occupational health and safety, and the regulation of collective bargaining and industrial action.

Students will be supplied with reading material relevant to the series of lectures. A number of the lecturers will also supply students with copies of papers and notes relevant to their presentations.

No formal qualifications are required for enrolment. It is assumed that participants may vary considerably in their previous knowledge and experience of different topics and therefore the seminars will necessarily be general.

Participants who attend a minimum of eight seminars in the series will be issued with a certificate of attendance.
