The Sydney Law School delivers one of the world's largest postgraduate programs in climate and environmental law. The program is taught by a distinguished group of Resident, Adjunct and International Faculty members, with extensive experience in environmental law.



The Master of Environmental Law at Sydney Law School is one of the largest postgraduate environmental law programs in the world. Its success is attributed to the fact that the program is constantly updated and expanded while maintaining a focus on core environmental law units of study.

Sydney Law School was the first Law School in Australia to teach a unit in Climate Law in 1998. Since then the Climate Law program has expanded to five specialist units of study. As well, a new focus for the program is the area of Global Energy Resources Law.

Units are taught by experts who are full-time members of the Law School as well as an Adjunct and International Faculty from Europe, the United States and Asia. The program has a strong international and comparative focus. All lecturers are experts in the areas in which they teach and have very active research programs which complement their teaching.

The Master of Environmental Law is an interdisciplinary program which requires students to have completed any undergraduate degree before applying to be enrolled in the program. The program is supported by the

Australian Centre for Climate and Environmental Law (ACCEL) at Sydney Law School. ACCEL runs an active conference program on the cutting edge Climate and Environmental Law issues of the day, many of which are interdisciplinary. All students are invited to attend conferences at reduced student rates. In this way, the activities of ACCEL enhance the experience of students in the postgraduate Environmental Law program.
