Sydney Law School offers a wide range of study options through which you can further your tax knowledge. You don't have to have a law degree to study tax at Sydney Law School. All tax subjects are open to students with a non-law background, such as in business, economics, or accounting.

Coursework programs

MTax:

8 postgraduate tax subjects of your choice

MIntTax:

Comparative International Tax plus 7 other tax subjects chosen from the international tax list (for those with an international background or focus)

LLM:

8 postgraduate law courses of your choice, including any number of tax courses (for students with an undergraduate law degree)

GradDipTax:

4 postgraduate tax subjects of your choice

Tax Office Support
