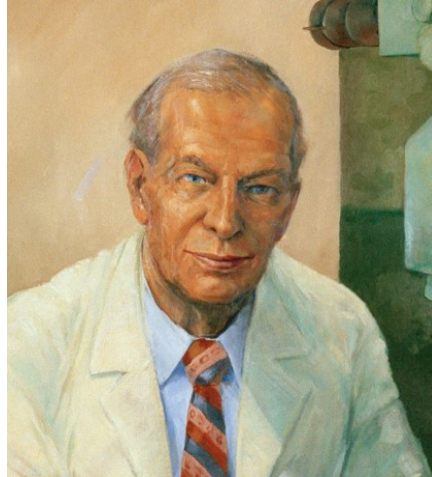




HL and PO Bishop Fellowship in Neuroscience 2019-2021



Application

The Bosch Institute invites applications for the HL and PO Bishop Fellowship in Neuroscience.

Endowed by the late Professor P.O. Bishop (Professor of Physiology, 1956-67), the Fellowship is to enable the awardee to undertake a project of 1 – 2 years' duration, which will further neuroscience in the Bosch Institute and more widely.

Applicants should set out the project or program of activities they would undertake during the Fellowship, and propose a budget of up \$50,000. Activities could include, but are not limited to:

- A visit to a neuroscience centre for collaborative work
- A novel development in neuroscience
- Improvement in the communication/teaching of neuroscience

The closing date for applications is 20 March 2019. The funds will be available from July 1 2019. There is no age guideline.

Preference will be given to a member of the Bosch Institute.

Applications should be submitted as a pdf file to the Institute's Chief Operating Officer (coo@bosch.org.au), with the filename *Bishop Fellowship 2019 your surname.pdf*.

It is planned to advise the outcome by 30 May 2019.
