## Symposium Outline

This symposium will be held over two days and is based on the IASP core curriculum. Sessions will be facilitated by leading specialists in the field of pain management. This symposium is designed for professionals with an interest in:

1. Cancer Pain
2. Complementary and Alternative Therapies

### Day 1: Cancer Pain

Participants explore contemporary issues in the management of cancer pain. To conclude the day an expert panel will lead a case presentation. Topic areas include:

- Neuropathic pain
- Opioid rotation
- Invasive and procedural treatments
- The role of the multidisciplinary team in palliative care
- Cancer pain syndromes
- Specific anti-cancer treatments
- Case study with panel discussion

### Day 2: Complementary and Alternative Therapies

The evidence and implications of the use of complementary and alternative therapies will also be discussed. A panel discussion with a range of experts in the field of complementary and alternative therapies will be included as part of this day.

- Chiropractic approaches
- Traditional Chinese medicine
- Homeopathy
- Mind-body approaches: hypnosis, yoga and meditation
