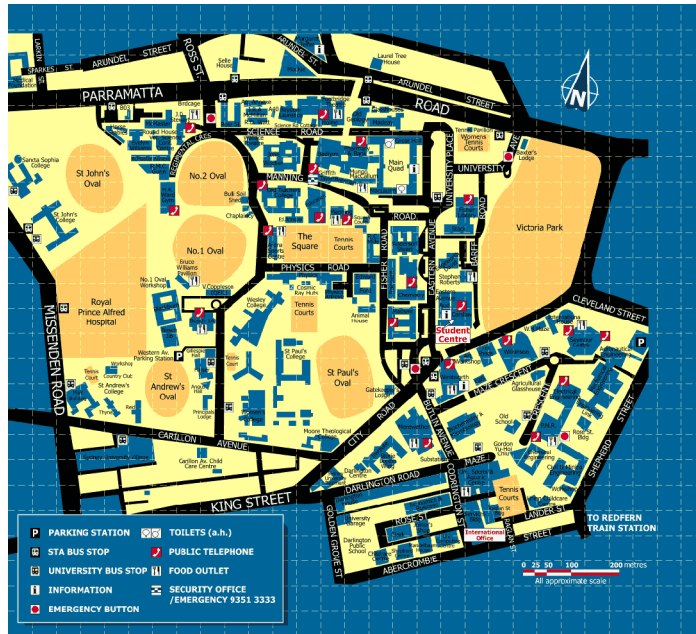


University of Sydney: Substance Abuse Research Day Wednesday 21 March, 9am – 5pm at the Darlington Centre
