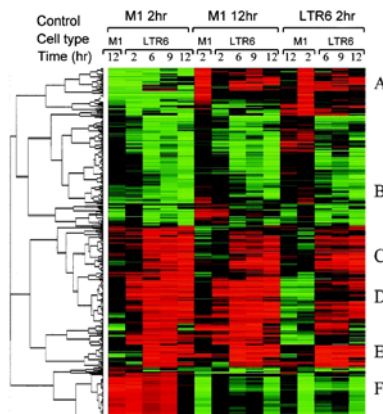

Sydney Bioinformatics will run two microarray workshops in 2009. The Introduction workshop is for people who are just starting with microarray analysis and the Advanced workshop (with Dr Jean Yang in Sydney only) is for people who are actively working on analysis of microarrays and/or have some experience in the techniques.

The Introduction workshop will be utilizing the software Chipster which is available at Sydney Bioinformatics. We will be covering the basics regarding to how to normalize data, clustering, statistics, pathway analysis, GEO information as it pertains to the software Chipster. This package works with affymetrix, agilent and illumine datasets. Chipster can be used after the workshop by those individuals whose department has a BioManager subscription. Chipster is a front end to the freely available BioConductor package.

The Advanced course will use other freely available packages.

Workshop are limited to 20 participants in NSW/QLD and 14 in Victoria. Payment of registration fee will confirm your place in the workshop.
