**Herbert and Valmae Freilich Scholarship
for Indigenous Australian Medical Students**

Terms and conditions

Established in 2006 following gifts by Herbert and Valmae Freilich to establish a scholarship to assist indigenous students with their medical studies.

The scholarships are awarded under the following conditions:

1. The scholarships shall be known as the “Herbert and Valmae Freilich Scholarship for Indigenous Australian Medical Students”.
2. The scholarship will be awarded by the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine to a candidate for the degrees of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery on the basis of both merit and need and will normally be awarded to one candidate but may be shared when, in the view of the Dean, two or more candidates are equally worthy of the scholarship.
3. The scholarship will be awarded to students who identify themselves as indigenous students, under the conditions set out by the University’s Koori Centre from time to time.
4. Preference in awarding the scholarships will be given to applicants who demonstrate a commitment to indigenous health and welfare.
5. The scholarship shall initially be awarded for one year and, subject to satisfactory performance, shall be renewed annually for the duration of the awardee’s candidature but may, at the discretion of the Dean, be renewed for one additional year
6. The value of the scholarship will be \$5,000 in the first instance, but from time to time will be adjusted to maximise the value of the scholarship without reducing the real value of the capital.
7. The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships.
