

Dean's Scholarship Fund
Elective Term / Independent Learning Activity Scholarship

Terms and conditions

The Dean's Scholarship Fund was established in 2007. The Elective Term / Independent Learning Activity Scholarship within the Dean's Scholarship Fund was created to facilitate the international experience for students enrolled as candidates for the degrees of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery.

The scholarship is awarded under the following conditions:

1. The name of the scholarship will be the Dean's Elective Term (or Independent Learning Activity) Scholarship.
2. The scholarship will be awarded by the Dean of Sydney Medical School on the recommendation of the Associate Dean (International) on behalf of the selection committee to students enrolled in the degrees of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery at the University of Sydney who have approval to travel overseas for an Elective Term / Independent Learning Activity.
3. The scholarship is intended to facilitate travel as part of an Elective Term / Independent Learning Activity only.
4. The value of the scholarship is up to \$3,000 and is tenable for the placement period only.
5. The scholarships may be held in conjunction with other scholarships.
6. Travel insurance will be provided by the University of Sydney in accordance with University policy at:
http://www.usyd.edu.au/audit_risk/insurance/travel/index.shtml. All other expenses must be met by the student.
7. The recipient may be required to refund all or part of the scholarship if he/she fails to complete the intended placement.
8. Sydney Medical School has the discretion not to award the scholarship if there are no applicants of sufficient merit and to share any award.
9. The number of scholarships awarded is dependent on available funds.
