

The Martin William Kimmings Elective Term Scholarship

Terms and conditions

Established in 2009 by Mrs Annie Kimmings to enable a candidate for the degrees of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) to undertake an Elective Term at an internationally regarded research centre or institute overseas.

The scholarship is awarded under the following conditions:

1. The name of the scholarship will be the Martin William Kimmings Elective Term Scholarship.
2. The scholarship will be awarded by the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine on the recommendation of the University of Sydney Medical Elective Exchange Program Committee, to a candidate for the degrees of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery at the University of Sydney who wishes to travel overseas to an internationally-regarded research institute or centre to further their interest in research.
3. The value of the scholarship will be up to \$5,000 and is tenable for the Elective Term period only.
4. The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships.
5. The recipient may be required to refund all or part of the scholarship if he/she fails to complete the intended study at the overseas institution.
6. The recipient will be expected to submit a brief report of about 500 words on completion of the intended study at the overseas institution.
7. The University of Sydney Medical Elective Exchange Program Committee has the discretion not to award the scholarship if there is no applicant of sufficient merit.
