

# The Baxter Scholarship for Excellence in Health Policy

2011 Application  
Closing Date: 31 January 2011

Established in 2006 by a donation from Baxter Healthcare to encourage excellence in the field of health policy. The scholarship shall be awarded under the following conditions:

1. The name of the scholarship shall be the Baxter Scholarship for Excellence in Health Policy.
2. The scholarship covers half the coursework fees for all core units and electives enrolled in at the University of Sydney.
3. The scholarship will only be awarded to students on full-fee paying places. Students on Commonwealth Supported Places are not eligible.
4. The scholarship shall be awarded by the Faculty of Medicine, on the recommendation of a Scholarship Committee comprising: The Director of the Menzies Centre for Health Policy at the University of Sydney, the Head of the School of Public Health; two members of the teaching staff in the Master of Health Policy and a representative of Baxter Healthcare.
5. The scholarship shall be tenable by students enrolled in the Master of Health Policy. Students already enrolled in the Graduate Certificate or Graduate Diploma in Health Policy, or who have graduated in either of these degrees, are not eligible to apply.
6. Applicants shall be required to submit an application form with full academic records attached and an essay of no more than 500 words discussing the aspects of health policy that most interest the applicant, referring to at least one current health policy dilemma.
7. The scholarship may not be awarded to an applicant who is in receipt of another award of equal or higher value.
8. The recipient of the scholarship is required to complete the Master of Health Policy within 4 years from date of commencement. Any scholarship funds not expended after this date will be forfeited.
9. Any fees charged for repeating units not passed on the first attempt will be the award recipient's responsibility.
10. The scholarship is open to employees of Baxter Healthcare.

## Supporting documentation

You are required to provide documentation in support of this application. If you do not attach all of the documents required your application may not be considered. The documents you have to provide include:

- Copy of full academic records
- Essay of no more than 500 words discussing the aspects of health policy that most interests the applicant, referring to at least one current health policy dilemma
- A letter of reference from someone familiar with your academic or professional work

If your supporting documents are not in English you must provide translated versions of those documents in addition to certified copies of the originals. These translations should be official. Some examples of the types of translations which may be accepted are those produced by the Community Relations Commission (CRC), the Department of Immigration, Multicultural and Indigenous Affairs (DIMIA), or by an accredited National Accreditation Authority for Translators and Interpreters (NAATI) translator of at least 'Translator' or 'Level 3' status. Please note that if you are providing copies of translations, rather than originals, those copies must also be certified.
