1. The scholarship is open to students enrolled full-time at Sydney College of the Arts in years two or three of a Bachelor of Visual Arts degree.
2. The scholarship may not be deferred.
3. The scholarship is non-continuing.
4. Applications must be submitted, on this form, to the SCA Scholarships Coordinator, 1st Floor Admin Building F24 at Sydney College of the Arts by the closing date.
5. A PowerPoint Presentation showcasing 10 recent works of the applicant or a DVD containing a moving image, sound or film work of not more than five minutes duration must be submitted.
6. The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of academic merit and financial need.
7. The scholarship will not be awarded to students who are, or in the same period will be, in receipt of any other scholarship or award.
8. The SCA Scholarships and Prizes Committee reserves the right to alter or modify existing awards in all categories in any given year, based on the recommendations and approval of the SCA Board.
