Selection criteria

- Academic merit
- Statement of need
- Portfolio

Applications will be assessed by the Scholarships Subcommittee of the Learning and Teaching Committee. Each member will score applications and the highest ranked eligible applicant will be awarded.

Payment schedule

- A single payment will be made after census date in Semester 2.

Termination

The scholarship will terminate if:

- The recipient withdraws from the Bachelor of Visual Arts; or
- The recipient discontinues from their studio major in the given semester.
