Although the Juris Doctor is a Postgraduate Coursework program, as both the Juris Doctor and the Bachelor of Laws must fulfil the same professional accreditation requirements, it is necessary that both largely share the same learning outcomes. Accordingly, the revised JD learning outcomes are also included in the attached template.
