

#### The Changing Face of St Ives for Stage 2

The goal of this unit is for students to connect with the history of their local area (St Ives). Students will explore who lived here first, how the area has changed, and the people that now live here. Our STEM project is for students to build a replica of St Ives from 100 years ago, using historical primary and secondary sources for accuracy. It was delivered as part of our History unit and used process diaries to track student progress.
