HEBREW UNIVERSITY OF JERUSALEM**

The Jerusalem Society of Medical Students offers visiting medical students in their clinical years the opportunity to practise a medical elective at the Hadassah University Hospital. Clinical clerkships are available for students who are already in their clinical years only. Its departments cover virtually every modern medical discipline. Places are available in surgery, cardiology, hematology, dermatology, radiology, obstetrics and gynecology, and more.

Hebrew is NOT required except for a clerkship in pediatrics, internal medicine, psychiatry and the Emergency Room. Housing may be available in the University dormitories.

ABOUT THE SIR ZELMAN COWEN UNIVERSITIES FUND FELLOWSHIP

- Two Fellowships valued at \$3,500 each, are offered annually, to contribute towards travel and accommodation expenses.
- If in any one year, the Trustees deem a greater number of applicants to be equally worthy of support, they may split the total sum of \$7,000 between that number of applicants which shall not number more than 4.
- On completion of their elective term, Fellowship recipients will be required to submit a brief report about their elective term.
