

Kath Farr Scholarship Fund

The Kath Farr Scholarship will be awarded annually to a final year female veterinary science student at the University of Sydney. An initiative of the Australian Veterinary Association, this scholarship will commemorate the life of one of Australia's pioneering female veterinarians, Dr Kathleen Farr OAM.

The scholarship, which is worth \$1,000 annually, has been established to encourage female students enrolled in the final year of a Bachelor of Veterinary Science to work in rural NSW.

Kath Farr was one of the University of Sydney's first female veterinary graduates and a trailblazer for women in the profession in Australia. After graduating in 1983 she went on to a successful career in government and army services, followed by private veterinary practice in rural NSW.

The AVA is calling for donations to the Fund through the Veterinary Science Foundation at the University of Sydney to help establish the fund as self supporting.
