

François Étienne Lharidon de Créméneç

Born 1768 in Douarnenez (Finistère)

Appointed to the *Géographe* as medical officer 2nd class but upgraded to 1st class on 13 October, six days before sailing

Age on departure from Le Havre: 32

Committed suicide by drowning in the Penfeld River (Brittany) in 1807
