



## CHINESE STUDIES

You can study a Chinese Studies major or minor, starting at the level most suited to your current ability. We have offerings suited to complete beginners through to heritage speakers.

### Introductory

- Beginner level, suitable for complete beginners or students with very little language experience.
- In first year, enrol in **CHNS1101 Chinese 1A** and **CHNS1102 Chinese 1B**.

### Intermediate

- e.g. HSC Beginners who receive a mark higher than 70 or HSC Continuers who receive less than 80.
- In first year, enrol in **CHNS2601 Chinese 2A** and **CHNS2602 Chinese 2B**.

### Advanced

- e.g. Post-HSC Continuers who receive a mark of 80 or higher, or HSC Extension.
- In first year, enrol in CHNS3601 Chinese 3A and CHNS3602 Chinese 3B.

### Heritage Speakers

- Native or near-native speakers with very low literacy, in first year, enrol in CHNS2001 Chinese 2C and CHNS2002 Chinese 2D.
- Native speakers who have passed HSC Chinese (Background) or have completed a major part of their secondary education in Chinese, in first year, enrol in **CHNS3000 Chinese for Native Speakers 1** and **CHNS3001 Chinese for Native Speakers 2**.

Once you enrol you will be able to access information and academic advice if you have more specific questions about what language level is most appropriate to you.

Please check your respective course resolutions to ensure specific units are eligible for combined degrees.
