



## **MODERN HEBREW STUDIES**

You can study Modern Hebrew as a major or minor, starting at the level most suited to your current ability. Please contact Dr Yona Gilead to arrange a placement test. We have offerings suited to complete beginners through to native speakers.

### **Introductory**

- Beginner level, suitable for complete beginners or students with very little language experience.
- In first year, enrol in **HBRW1011 Foundations of Modern Hebrew 1** and **HBRW1102 Foundations of Modern Hebrew 2**.

### **Intermediate**

- e.g. HSC Beginners who receive a mark higher than 70 or HSC Continuers who receive less than 80.
- In first year, enrol in **HBRW2603 Using Modern Hebrew in the Here-and-Now** and **HBRW2604 Modern Hebrew in Everyday Context**.

### **Advanced**

- e.g. Post-HSC Continuers who receive a mark of 80 or higher, or HSC Extension.
- In first year, enrol in **HBRW3610 Modern Hebrew, a Living Language** and **HBRW3611 Modern Hebrew for Life**.

Once you enrol you will be able to access information and academic advice if you have more specific questions about what language level is most appropriate to you.

Please check your respective course resolutions to ensure specific units are eligible for combined degrees.
