Our ESIPS program is designed to offer our industry partners the opportunity to work with some of our highest achieving students during the final year of their studies.

For a financial commitment, your organisation will benefit from the fresh ideas and enthusiasm this next generation of engineering, computing and project management leaders can bring to your team's working environment.

Over the course of a six-month full-time industry placement, each student involved in the program undertakes a high-level investigative project, based on your organisation's need. The outcomes of the project will ultimately be presented to you and your colleagues.

Our first-class talent

Senior students arrive having successfully met our in-depth application criteria, which your organisation is invited to participate in.

Candidates are evaluated on their academic studies and merit, including their likelihood of graduating with First Class Honours, as well as their personal qualities, extra-curricular activities and community-based pursuits.

Timing

Our ESIPS recipients may undertake a six-month industry placement with your organisation, preferably onsite at your organisation's premises, between either:

- January–June, or
- June–December

All students participating in the ESIPS program are covered by our "Insurance for Students on Work Placement" policy.

Answering your business needs

We will provide an academic supervisor for your student to assess the suitability (academic content and conformance) of the project while ensuring it also provides a strong financial return for your company.

The academic supervisor will follow your student's progress throughout the project's duration as they seek out and use appropriate resources; identify investigation directions and methodology; write and develop the thesis and any reports needed; and final presentation.

You will be able to track your student's progress on a number of presentations which will take place during and upon completion of the project. Completion of the project, should you wish to offer them a position as a graduate or part-time employee, they will be able to add value to your business straight away.

Your financial commitment

As a scholarship partner, your total financial commitment will be \$33,000 per student for each six-month placement. This costing covers:

- \$22,000 student scholarship to the student
- \$11,000 in associated Administration and operational costs.

Additional travel expenses and assistance with accommodation costs will be required for all placements located outside the greater-Sydney region.
