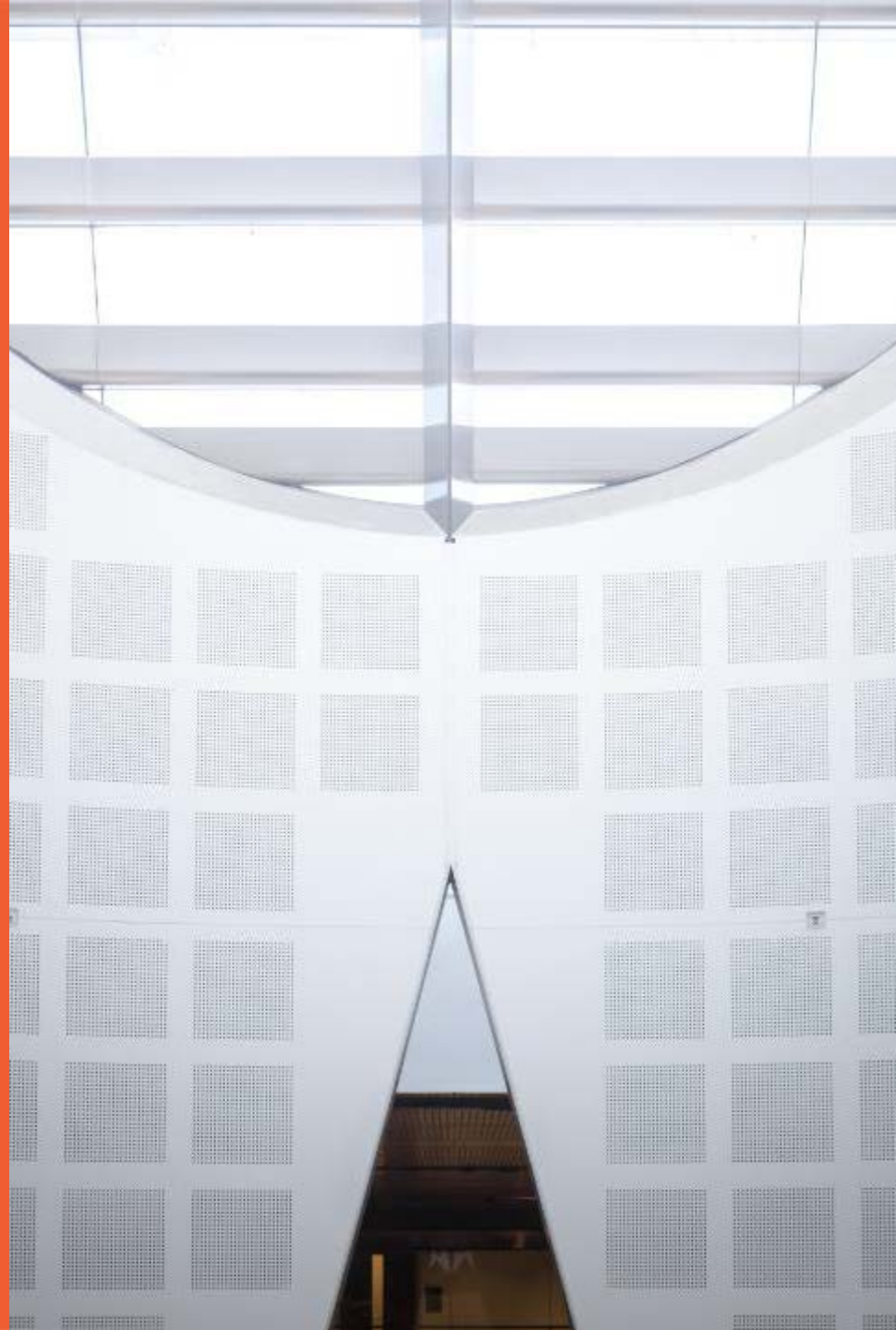

# **Bachelor of Nursing (Honours)**

- Provides an opportunity for high achieving students from the Bachelor of Nursing to conduct an independent research project under supervision
- Designed to equip students with readiness to undertake research and potentially progress to doctoral studies
- 48 credit points
- 1 year full-time OR 2 years part-time

## Admission to the Bachelor of Nursing (Honours):

- Bachelor of Nursing or equivalent awarded by the University of Sydney with a credit average or above
- Equivalent qualifications from other universities with a minimum weighted average mark of 65 (GPA 3.25)
- Current registration as a registered nurse in Australia
- Qualifications used as the basis for admission must have been completed less than 10 years prior to the application.
