Internationally recognised for her expertise in interprofessional education, Jill will discuss “*Research in interprofessional education*”.

Professor Lynn Monrouxe is currently the Associate Dean of Work Integrated Learning, Faculty of Health Sciences at the University of Sydney, having recently joined us from Taiwan where she was Director of the Chang Gung Medical Education Research Centre. She has extensive national and international research collaborations, with a focus on professional practice and learning, and the development of patient-centred professionalism in healthcare students, medical students’ and residents’ professional identity formation and their transitions from students to doctors. Lynn will discuss “*Improving interprofessionalism practice through reflections on workplace dilemmas*”.
