

Prize for Academic Excellence in Sustainability Coursework

Terms and Conditions

1. Background

a. This prize has been established to reward an outstanding student with the best overall academic performance in either a Master of Sustainability or Diploma in Sustainability at the University of Sydney.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- a. To be considered eligible for this Prize, students must be currently enrolled in a Master of Sustainability and completing the capstone requirement of the degree or completed the Diploma of Sustainability in the year of award and achieved the highest Weighted Average Mark (WAM).
- b. Students must have completed 36 credit points of core units and 12 credit points of elective units at the time of award.

3. Selection Criteria

- a. The Prize will be awarded based on academic merit in the prior year of studies, as determined by the Weighted Average Mark (WAM) and having completed 36 credit points core units and 12 credit points of elective units.
- b. The Prize will be awarded on the nomination of the Dean of the Faculty of Science in consultation with the Master of Sustainability Program Committee, or their nominated delegates.

4. Value

- a. This Prize has a value up to \$750 and will be paid as a one-off payment after the relevant census date.
- b. If there are multiple recipients, the prize value will be shared amongst the recipients.
- c. No other amount is payable.
- d. The Prize will be awarded subject to the availability of funds.

5. Ongoing Eligibility

a. None apply.
