

Mrs MA Ching Prize

Terms and Conditions

1. Background

a. The Mrs MA Ching prize is awarded to an international student for the highest academic achievement in the Institute of Transport and Logistics Studies (ITLS) specialisation in the Master of Commerce.

2. Eligibility Criteria

To be considered eligible for this Prize, students must:

- a. be international students, and
- b. have completed at least 24 Credit Points of ITLS units of study in the Master of Commerce.

3. Selection Criteria

- a. The Prize will be awarded to the student with the highest annual average mark across ITLS units of the year.
- b. Where two or more students are equally qualified the Prize will be split between the students.

4. Value

- a. This Prize has a value of \$1000 and will be paid as a one-off payment.
- b. No other amount is payable.
- c. The Prize will be awarded subject to the availability of funds.

5. Ongoing Eligibility

a. None apply.

6. Termination

- a. The University reserves the right to withdraw the Prize, if the University determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information that has a relationship to the awarding of this Prize.
- b. Once withdrawn the Prize will not be reinstated unless due to University error.
