

Faculty of Medicine and Health Thesis Excellence Prize

Terms and Conditions

1. Background

a. The FMH Thesis Excellence Prize was established to recognise candidates for the high quality of their presented thesis.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- a. Students must be a Doctor of Philosophy candidate from one of the following schools:
 - I. The University of Sydney Susan Wakil School of Nursing and Midwifery,
 - II. The University of Sydney School of Health Sciences,
 - III. The University of Sydney School of Dentistry, or
 - IV. The University of Sydney School of Pharmacy.
- b. Students must pass thesis examination without the requirement for any emendations, amendments or corrections.
- c. Students must have not exceeded 3.5 EFTSL at the time of thesis submission.

3. Selection Criteria

a. The prize will be awarded on the recommendation of the Associate Dean (Research Education), Faculty of Medicine and Health.

4. Value

- a. This value of the prize will be determined by the Associate Dean (Research Education), Faculty of Medicine and Health.
- b. The value will be paid as a one-off payment.
- c. If more than one student is of equal merit, the value of the prize may be shared.
- d. No other amount is payable.
- e. The Prize will be awarded subject to the availability of funds.
- 5. Ongoing Eligibility
- a. None apply.
- 6. Termination

- a. The University reserves the right to withdraw the Prize, if the University determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information that has a relationship to the awarding of this Prize.
