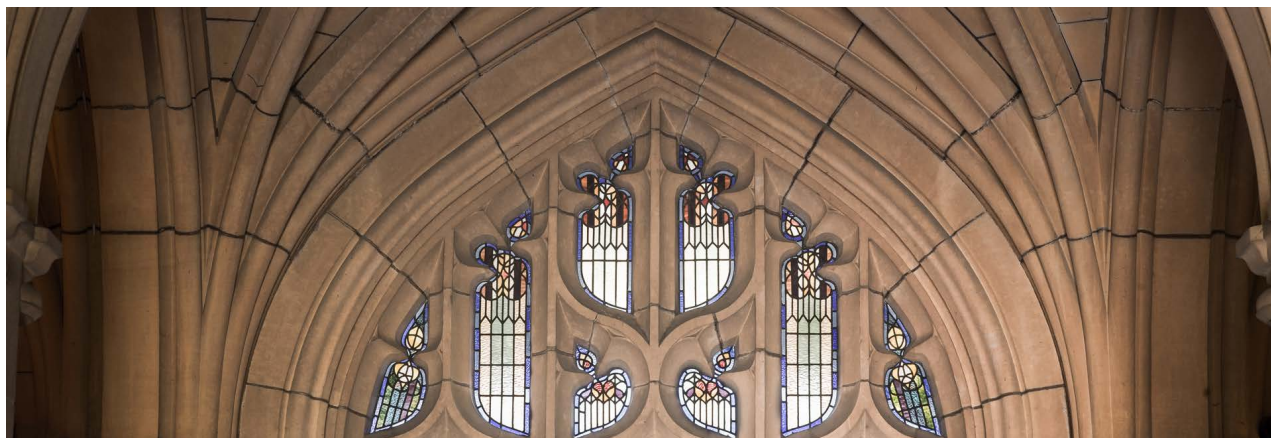


# Application checklist

| 3 | <input type="checkbox"/> Find out 'How to Apply'             | To apply for a Commonwealth supported place (CSP), you will apply through the Universities Admissions Centre (UAC)* and follow the prompts through: <a href="https://uac.edu.au">uac.edu.au</a> . Please refer to the UAC website for key dates. All domestic applicants are eligible for CSPs. Your application will be considered on the basis of your year 12 or equivalent school leaving qualification. To check the entry requirements for your state year 12 qualification, visit: <a href="https://sydney.edu.au/ug-entry">sydney.edu.au/ug-entry</a> .<br><br>*If you are applying for a Sciences Po dual degree you must apply directly to the University even if you are applying through UAC for other courses. | 4 | <input type="checkbox"/> Explore entry options               | If you are unsure if you will get the marks needed for your preferred course, check Access Sydney to see if you are eligible for any alternative entry pathways: <a href="https://sydney.edu.au/access">sydney.edu.au/access</a>   |
| 5 | <input type="checkbox"/> See what scholarships are available | We award many scholarships each year. Check the Scholarships website for more information: <a href="https://sydney.edu.au/scholarships">sydney.edu.au/scholarships</a>   |

| 8 | <input type="checkbox"/> Accept your offer                   | Once you receive an offer from the University of Sydney via UAC you will be sent more information on how to accept or defer your place. ### Year 12 comparison table

Since the late 1990s all Australian states and territories (except Queensland) have used a common measure to rank Year 12 students for university admission. In 2010 the Australasian Conference of Tertiary Admission Centres, of which UAC is a member, agreed that a common name for this measure would be adopted: the Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR). Therefore, if you are completing your Year 12 studies in 2010 or later in any state or territory – except Queensland – and are planning to apply

to institutions in other states or territories, your ATAR remains the same. For example, an ATAR of 81.00 in any state or territory is the same as an ATAR of 81.00 from any other state or territory (except Queensland). Queensland, however, measures Year 12 students using the measure Overall Position (OP). The table below shows how the ATAR equated to Queensland Overall Positions in 2014. This table should only be used as a guide to how 2015 ATARs and OPs will equate.
