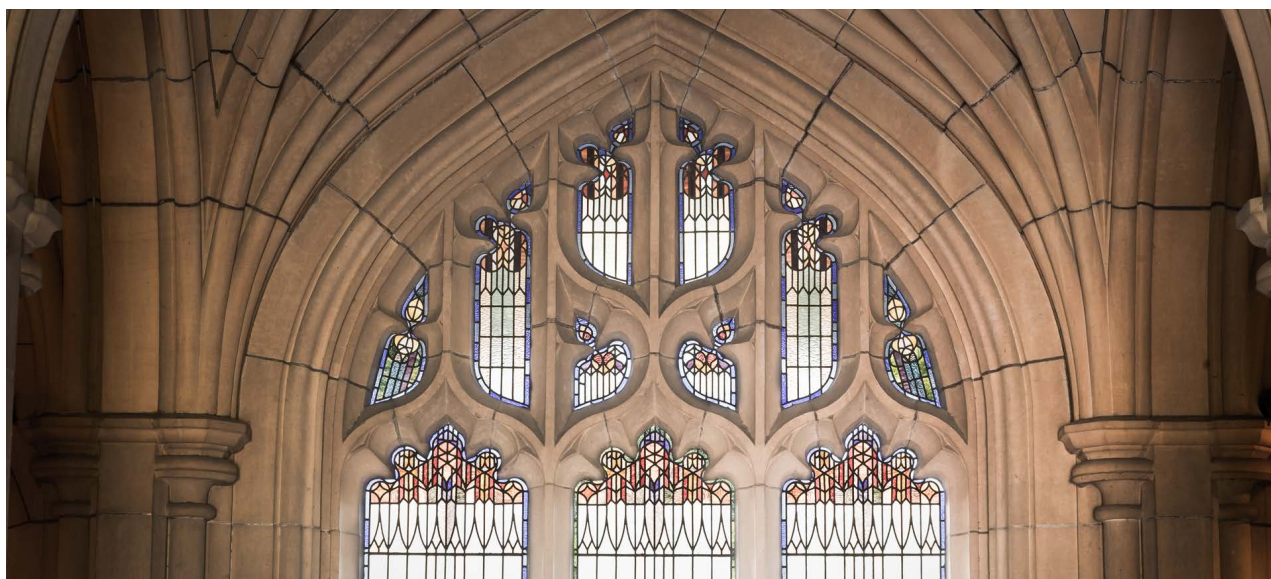


# Application checklist

Below are eight steps to help interstate domestic students apply for undergraduate study at the University of Sydney.

1	<input type="checkbox"/> Research	Research the courses available at the University of Sydney by visiting: <a href="https://sydney.edu.au/courses">sydney.edu.au/courses</a> You may also like to visit us for a campus tour, or attend major events such as Open Day in August. 2	<input type="checkbox"/> Check entry requirements	Make note of the entry requirements relating to your course. Some courses may have specific selection criteria and assumed knowledge. <b>Note:</b> There are currently no course prerequisites but course prerequisites will apply for admission from 2019. More information can be found at: <a href="https://sydney.edu.au/ug-entry">sydney.edu.au/ug-entry</a> . 3	<input type="checkbox"/> Find out 'How to Apply'	To apply for a Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP), you will apply through the Universities Admissions Centre (UAC)* and follow the prompts through: <a href="https://uac.edu.au">uac.edu.au</a> . Please refer to the UAC website for key dates. All domestic applicants are eligible for CSPs. Your application will be considered on the basis of your year 12 or equivalent school leaving qualification.  *If you are applying for a Sciences Po dual degree you must apply directly to the University even if you are applying through UAC for other courses. You can do so via the University's Find a Course website. <a href="https://sydney.edu.au/courses">sydney.edu.au/courses</a> , Search for your course, then click on the 'Apply Now' button on the course page.
4	<input type="checkbox"/> Explore entry options	If you are unsure if you will get the marks needed for your preferred course, check Access Sydney to see if you are eligible for any alternative entry pathways: <a href="https://sydney.edu.au/access">sydney.edu.au/access</a>
5	<input type="checkbox"/> See what scholarships are available	We award many scholarships each year. Check the Scholarships website for more information: <a href="https://sydney.edu.au/scholarships">sydney.edu.au/scholarships</a>
6	<input type="checkbox"/> Check out the accommodation options	Explore the accommodation options by visiting our student accommodation website: <a href="https://sydney.edu.au/accommodation">sydney.edu.au/accommodation</a>
7	<input type="checkbox"/> Apply through UAC	Make sure you are aware of important dates and deadlines: <a href="https://uac.edu.au/undergraduate/key-dates.shtml">uac.edu.au/undergraduate/key-dates.shtml</a> . Once you have chosen the degree, submit your application via UAC. You can find out the UAC code for the degree of your choice on the UAC website or the UAC Guide: <a href="https://sydney.edu.au/courses">sydney.edu.au/courses</a> .
8	<input type="checkbox"/> Accept your offer	Once you receive an offer from the University of Sydney via UAC you will be sent more information on how to accept or defer your place. You will also receive additional information on orientation, enrolment and important dates. <a href="https://sydney.edu.au/start">sydney.edu.au/start</a>
