We have introduced a guaranteed Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) for most of our courses, to simplify the application process and make it more transparent. This removes the uncertainty about what's required for entry, so you can have the confidence to list your dream course as your first preference.

The ATARs shown here guarantee entry to the University of Sydney (except where marked with an asterisk) and will not change throughout the preference and admissions period.

To be offered a place in a guaranteed-ATAR course at the University of Sydney, all you need to do is list that course as your first preference when you apply, and then achieve the guaranteed ATAR, International Baccalaureate (IB) or equivalent score in your Year 12 studies.

In this table, you can see the criteria for admission to our courses in 2019. Note that not all of our courses have a guaranteed ATAR, as some have limited places and/or additional admission criteria. Learn more:
